MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, October 9th., 1930, and was called to order at 5:30 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

RESOLUTION NO. 476.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE THAT THE LEGAL FIRM OF O'MELVENY, TULLER AND MYERS BE AND THEY ARE EMPLOYED TO BE ASSOCIATED WITH PERRY G. BRINEY, CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, IN THE DEFENSE OF THE DEFENDANTS IN THE CERTAIN SUIT IN EQUITY IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE UNITED STATES, SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA, CENTRAL DIVISION, WHICH SUIT IS NUMBERED S-49-C AND ENTITLED GEORGE W. DILLING VS. CITY OF TORRANCE, ET AL. THE COMPENSATION OF SUCH FIRM TO BE ONE AND ONE-FOURTH PER CENT ($1\frac{1}{4}\%$) AS A MINIMUM, AND TWO PER CENT (2%) AS A MAXIMUM, OF THE AMOUNT INVOLVED IN SUCH SUIT FOR SUCH SERVICES THROUGH THE TRIAL COURT, AND SUCH FEES TO BE REDUCED IN A REASONABLE AMOUNT IN CASE OF DISMISSAL BEFORE JUDGMENT.

Trustee Bell moved that Resolution No. 476 be adopted.
