MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, December 30th., 1930, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Trustees: Bell, Nelson, Smith, Steiner and Dennis.

Absent: Trustees: None.

Mr. Bartlett introduced a request from Mr. Joe Stevens, "The Popcorn Man", to put in a tamale stand in connection with his peanuts and popcorn. Said stand to be about 15 inches square and 22 inches high.

Trustee Steiner moved that a permit be granted.

Trustee Smith seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

The unemployment situation was discussed.

Trustee Nelson suggested that this would be a good time to paint the house numbers on the surbs as was discussed sometime ago, and give some men work who are in great need of it.

Trustee Nelson stated that the sidewalk on Redondo Blvd. over Madrid Avenue and Railroad Tracks which was recently constructed by the Santa Fe Railway Company, should be acknowledged.

+ AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE X

OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) OF BONDS OF ACT OF 1927 MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, AUTHORIZED BY THE VOTERS OF SUCH DISTRICT AT A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD SEPTEMBER 26, 1930, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING A WATER PRODUCING AND DISTRIBUTING SYSTEM FOR SAID DISTRICT INCLUDING WELLS, PUMPS, TANKS, RESERVOIRS, DISTRIBUTION MAINS, LANDS, RIGHTS OF WAY, AND EASEMENTS THEREFOR AND ALL OTHER NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES FOR A COMPLETE WATER PRODUCING, PURIFYING, AND DISTRIBUTING SYSTEM FOR THE SALE OF WATER FOR DOMESTIC, AGRICULTURAL, INDUSTRIAL AND OTHER USES.

Trustee Bell moved that Ordinance No. 212 be adopted for its final reading.

Trustee Smith seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:
