

Drawing and Painting in the Impressionistic Style of Watercolor

Instructor: Hisako Asano

The beautiful, dreamy style of impressionistic Japanese watercolor is the trademark of Hisako Asano's painting. Learn to create paintings that capture the essence of this softly colored art form. Students will learn to mix and blend colors, observe and capture objects on paper, use brush strokes for different effects, and create three-dimensional images with a single stroke.

MATERIALS LIST

- 1 ½ inch - Hake Brush (made in Japan)
- Strathmore 300 series watercolor paper
- Water container
- Paper towels or towel
- Transparent watercolor in tube in these colors: Alizarin Crimson – Burnt Sienna - Lemon Yellow – Payne's Grey – Prussian Blue – Sap Green
- Watercolor palette or some type of plate to mix watercolors
