MOTION: Member Chaparyan, seconded by Member Reyes, moved to accept and file the report of the City Clerk on the posting of the agenda for this meeting; hearing no objection, Chairman Smith so ordered.

5. BUSINESS LICENSE APPLICATIONS

5A. DAVID MACHADO

Application for approval of a Solicitor's Permit to work for A-Machado Paints.

David Machado, owner of A-Machado Paints, Santa Fe Springs, confirmed his application for a Solicitor's Permit to allow him to solicit business for his company and confirmed that he understood the rules and regulations pertaining to solicitors.

MOTION: Member Chaparyan moved to approve David Machado's application for a Solicitor's Permit. The motion was seconded by Member Reyes and voice vote reflected unanimous approval.

5C. BISHOP MONTGOMERY CLASS OF '85

Application for approval of a Sound Permit.

Chairman Smith explained that a Sound Permit was requested for a class reunion to be held on July 17, 2010 from 6:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m., however staff was recommending denial of the application because according to TMC §46.5.3(b), the amplified sound cannot go beyond 9:00 p.m.

Diane Dibrell, representing Bishop Montgomery High School Class of '85, stated that the reunion is already scheduled to go until 10:30 p.m.; that the company supplying the music has already been paid; and that it would be a hardship to end the music after only 2 ½ hours. She noted the reunion will take place inside the Bishop Montgomery gymnasium with the doors closed and will not disturb neighbors.

Sr. Account Clerk Weldin reported that it has been the Board's practice to approve a Sound Permit only within the hours permitted by the Code, but if the amplified music goes beyond that time, enforcement would occur on a complaint-basis only.

MOTION: Member Chaparyan moved for the approval of the Sound Permit on July 17, 2010 from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The motion was seconded by Member Reyes, and voice vote reflected unanimous approval.
