ADVANCE NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Dear Resident:

This notice is to inform you that beginning Monday, October 17, 2016, the City's contractor, Beador Construction Company, Inc., will begin the safety improvements along Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) which consists of tree removals, new guard rail and fencing. Operation in this area is scheduled to take place through January 2017.

Working hours are weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS AND ACCESS

Southbound PCH will be reduced from two lanes down to one lane during working hours.

Should there be a need to restrict parking on the residential side of the PCH service road, No Parking signs will be posted at least 48 hours in advance of the work. Please obey the signs, or your vehicle may be towed.

At the end of the day, construction areas will be accessible.
