Torrance City Council Appoints Kurt Weideman to Fill Vacant Council Seat

Torrance, Calif., July 24, 2013 – The Torrance City Council appointed a new member Tuesday night to replace Susan M. Rhilinger, who resigned due to health issues.

The council selected Kurt Weideman, former Chairman of the El Camino College Bond Oversight Committee and Torrance Cultural Arts Center Foundation President; and current Torrance Historical Society President. Weideman was also a current Commissioner on the Torrance Planning Commission, and resigned his commissioner duties just before taking his oath on City Council.

Weideman stated, “I am solution oriented, and have the ability to listen and coordinate differing viewpoints for expedient, fair, and progressive solutions.” After being elected in the third round of voting by the City Council, the retired Aerospace Executive joined his new colleagues on the dais for the remainder of the meeting.

Weideman declared his integrity, enthusiasm, and commitment to the City of Torrance before the City Council. “I take very seriously the responsibility of a City Council position. It requires a person of an upright, honest and trustful character. I endeavor to represent those characteristics in all aspects of my life— personal, business, and civic— and would do so as a councilmember.”
