NOTICE OF STREET CONSTRUCTION

Torrance Boulevard Rehabilitation

Dear Citizen,

Construction activity on Torrance Boulevard has started between **Crenshaw Boulevard and Maple Avenue**. The City's contractor, Sully-Miller Contracting Co., is working on the south side (eastbound direction) of the roadway. After work on the south side is complete, work will begin on the north side (westbound direction) and then finally progress to the middle section. The total duration of all work in this area will be approximately eight weeks. Normal work hours are weekdays between 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m..

TRAFFIC IMPACTS AND ACCESS – CRENSHAW BOULEVARD TO MAPLE AVENUE

Stage 1 Construction - South Side: Eastbound traffic on Torrance Boulevard will be reduced to one lane on a 24-hour basis. On-street parking also will be prohibited on a 24-hour basis.

Stage 2 Construction - North Side: Westbound traffic will be reduced to one lane on a 24-hour basis.

Stage 3 Construction - Middle lanes: Both eastbound and westbound traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction and left turns will be restricted on a 24-hour basis.

Note: At times during stages 1 and 2, access into and out of side streets and driveways between Crenshaw Boulevard and Maple Avenue will be temporarily prohibited during working hours to complete the work. During all stages of construction, the bike lane will be closed on a 24 hour basis.

Delays are expected, so we recommend using an alternate route. We thank you for your cooperation and patience during the construction.
