

Dear Coaches,

In our continuing efforts to provide a positive, safe and fun environment for young athletes, the **City of Torrance** is proud to implement the National Youth Sports Coaches Association training and membership program for coaches.

We join more than 3,000 organizations across the country conducting the NYSCA program and invite you to join the more than 3 million volunteer coaches who have become NYSCA members since its inception 1981.

The NYSCA training will provide all of our coaches with important general and sport-specific coaching information. After completing the training, your NYSCA membership will be in effect. Membership includes an ID card, \$1,000,000 limited liability insurance policy, access to members-only resources, plus additional free training. The NYSCA fee, paid for by the City of Torrance, includes the training and your first year of membership.

To register for the NYSCA training, go to www.nays.org/nyscaonline. Be sure to choose **City of Torrance Community Services Department CHP-7892** as your Chapter. The Online Clinic will allow you to complete the training at your own pace, and will take approximately 2 ½- 3 hours to complete. You will be able to start, stop, or revisit the training at any time if you do not wish to complete it all at once.

We ask you to complete the training by **September 15, 2016**. However, if you do not wish to complete the training online, you are invited to participate in our Onsite Clinic. This clinic will be held on Saturday, September 17th from 9:00 AM to noon in the West Annex Conference Room, located at 3031 Torrance Blvd. The Onsite Clinic will include open discussion, coach's feedback, and much more!

Coaches must complete this training in order to receive their rosters and equipment. If you have completed the Online Clinic prior to September 15th, you will receive your rosters and equipment at the coaches meeting. If you choose to attend the Onsite Clinic on September 17th, your rosters and equipment will be given to you following the completion of the clinic.
