Results from Safety Checkpoint

On Wednesday October 21, 2009 the Torrance Police Department sponsored a Seatbelt and Drivers License Checkpoint from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the eastbound lanes of the 2600 block of Redondo Beach Boulevard.

All too often, members of our community are senselessly injured or killed on local roadways by unlicensed drivers or because they failed to wear their seatbelt. This Drivers License and Seatbelt Checkpoint was an effort to reduce those tragedies by getting unlicensed drivers and their vehicles off the streets and educating the public on the dangers of driving without wearing a seatbelt.

As a result of this Safety Checkpoint, over 2,000 drivers were contacted, 26 were arrested for driving without a drivers license or with a suspended license, 26 vehicles were impounded, one was arrested for a warrant, and 29 others were cited for other violations.
