

## SUGGESTED TARA NET CALLUP PROCEDURE

***The following dialog is to be used as a guide to conduct net when necessary from a location remote to the EOC. NC operators at the EOC should use the script contained in the 3 ring binder in the EOC.***

QST, QST, QST. This is **W6TPD**, net control for the Torrance Amateur Radio Association Emergency Communications Net. This net meets on Monday evenings at 7:00PM on 223.880 MHz **repeater**.

All amateurs are welcome to participate.

### **NOTE: Do 220 MHz only**

This is **(your name, your call)** acting as Net Control. Please stand by for roll call. Any relays would be appreciated. **Please give your call sign in phonetics**, Tactical DCS call if any, and hours spent on providing radio amateur public service or improving your equipment or operating skills since you last checked in.

To avoid pile up, roll call will be taken by zip codes 90501 through 90505. All other zip codes will follow 90505

Roll call is now complete. This is the Torrance Emergency Communications Net W6TPD. Are there any late or visitor check-ins? Please come now.

The TARA Board of Directors meets at 1930 hours the first Monday of the month, in the Police Department Seminar Room on the second floor. All TARA members and applicants are invited to participate. You will need your DSV ID or obtain a visitor's pass to access the TPD second floor.
