Victory Garden Guide Is Issued

A victory garden guide, especially prepared for Los Angeles county, is now available for free distribution upon request to his office, 808 N. Spring st., Los Angeles 12, County Farm Advisor C. V. Castle announced.

Authorized by the Board of Supervisors, the guide discusses soils, irrigation, fertilization, disease and pest control and crop rotation. In addition, 25 vegetables are dealt with and a planting calendar covering 15 of the most popular and valuable vegetables is included.
