- 12) Work at the Torrance Airport is allowed on weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Cat-tracking for proposed pavement markings and the installation of temporary reflective "tabs" MUST occur on the same day as slurry seal application. Final pavement markings must be installed no fewer than seven (7) calendar days and no more than fourteen (14) calendar days following slurry seal application.

Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:

~~Payment for thermoplastic traffic striping on arterial streets shall be on a lump sum basis per the Contract Unit Price for various bid items for "INSTALL PAVEMENT STRIPING, MARKINGS, LEGENDS, AND RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS" and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, necessary to complete the Work.~~

Payment for thermoplastic traffic striping on arterial streets (Bid Schedule B) shall be on a lump sum basis per the Contract Unit Price for various bid items for "INSTALL PAVEMENT STRIPING, MARKINGS, LEGENDS, AND RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS" and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, necessary to complete the Work.

Add the following after Paragraph 2:

Payment for traffic striping, pavement marking, pavement markers, and pavement legends on residential streets (Bid Schedule A), in City parking facilities (Bid Schedule C), and at the airport (Bid Schedule D) shall be on a lump sum basis per the Contract Unit Price for various bid items for "INSTALL PAVEMENT STRIPING, MARKINGS, LEGENDS, AND RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS" in the Bidder's Proposal, and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, necessary to complete the Work, as specified in the Specifications and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

All costs for establishing alignment of traffic stripes, pavement markings, pavement markers, layout, temporary pavement painting, and sandblasting of existing lines and markings shall be included and no extra costs will be allowed.


