Wilson Park Batting Cages Closing for Improvements on December 1

Torrance, Calif., November 26, 2008 – With the approval of the Torrance City Council, the Torrance Community Services Department entered into an agreement with Tyler Sports, Inc. to operate and conduct improvements to the Batting Cage Facility at Charles H. Wilson Park located at 2200 Crenshaw Boulevard. Improvements entail closure of the facility starting December 1, 2008, until the targeted completion date of January 2009.

Improvements include installation of new fast pitch machines, upgrade of lighting and netting, and a refurbishment of its aesthetic look. Overall, improvements will provide a better facility for the community prior to the upcoming baseball season. In contracting with Tyler Sports Inc., an operator of batting cage facilities for 30 years, the City of Torrance is providing the community with a premier batting cage facility.
