Torrance City Council Appoints Mike Griffiths to Fill Vacant Council Seat

Torrance, Calif., Aug. 13, 2014 – The Torrance City Council appointed Mike Griffiths to City Council Tuesday night to replace Mayor Patrick J. Furey, who left an open council seat when he won the June 3rd, 2014 mayoral election.

Griffiths, an IT Management and Financial Manufacturing Resource Planning Software Administrator, ran for a seat in the June 3rd Torrance City Council election. A current Planning Commissioner, he also served 2 terms as a Commissioner on the Torrance Environmental Quality and Energy Conservation Commission where he was elected 3 consecutive times as chair.

Griffiths has been a Torrance resident since 1983 and has participated with community groups such as the Torrance South-Bay YMCA, Riviera Elementary School, Richardson Middle School and South High, to name a few.

In his application for appointment to Torrance City Council Griffiths stated, “I am a logical thinker and do my best to look at the big-picture as well as the long-term ramifications when making decisions.”

Mike Griffiths also stated he will run in the June 7th, 2016 Torrance Election.
