MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chamber at Torrance, California, April 4th., 1933, and was called to order at 7:45 P.M. by Mayor Klusman.

The following Councilmen were present: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock, Ludlow, Wright and Klusman. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Mayor Klusman stated the meeting was for the purpose of adopting Ordinance No. 240 for its final reading. Clerk Bartlett read Ordinance No. 240.

Before a motion was called for, Councilman Wright asked the Council to accept his resignation from the Ordinance Committee. Councilman Conner moved Councilman Wright's resignation from the Ordinance Committee be accepted with regrets. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Conner moved that Councilman Hitchcock be appointed Chairman of the Ordinance Committee. As there was no second to this motion, Councilman Conner then moved that Mayor Klusman be appointed Chairman of the Ordinance Committee. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Conner moved that Ordinance No. 240 be adopted for its final reading. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock, Wright and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMAN: Ludlow. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE
REGULATING THE MANUFACTURE, POSSESSION,
TRANSPORTATION, DISTRIBUTION AND SALE
OF NON-INTOXICATING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that a filing fee of \$5.00 be charged for applications filed for permit or license to sell beverages, such fee to apply on payment of permit or license fee if application is accepted, and to be refunded if rejected, and total license fee not to exceed \$50.00. Councilman Ludlow seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Ludlow moved Ordinance No. 241 be approved for its first reading. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Ludlow said he would like to introduce a Resolution to be sent to the Board of Supervisors requesting moratorium on the payment of taxes, owing to the many banks being closed and the consequent tie up of funds. Councilman Conner said Mr. Whyte of the Torrance Herald has some State information. Mr. Whyte stated that there is a bill before the State Legislature whereby they will advance the date from April 20th. to June 20th. Councilman Ludlow moved the City Clerk wire the proper party in Sacramento for support to this bill, and also write a letter to the Board of Supervisors. Councilman Wright seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Ludlow was excused at 9 o'clock P.M.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the meeting be adjourned. Councilman Wright seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 9 o'clock P.M.
