MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, March 6th., 1934.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ludlow at 7:45 P.M.

Mayor Ludlow stated this being an adjourned meeting, the regular order of business is suspended.

City Clerk Bartlett called the roll. Those answering present were Councilmen: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Wright and Ludlow. Absent: Councilmen: None.

City Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the members of the Future Farmers of America, Torrance High School Chapters requesting permission to erect a temporary stand on the Southeast corner of Arlington and Plaza Del Amo for the purpose of marketing farm products grown by the members. Councilman Klusman moved a temporary permit be issued. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

A petition requesting the Council help procure aid from the proper Governmental Agency to foster and maintain musical organizations was read. Councilman Hitchcock moved \$20.00 be appropriated for the purpose of purchasing music for the proposed municipal band. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, the record of the vote is as follows:

A communication from the Metlox Manufacturing Company requesting approval to erect a double faced vertical neon sign at 1401 Sartori Avenue was read. Engineer Leonard stated the plan that they offer for hanging the sign is O.K. Councilman Hitchcock moved the request be granted, and City Clerk to issue permit and notify them of the fee. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF
LEASE WITH WALTERIA LUMBER COMPANY.

Councilman Klusman moved the reading of the resolution be waived. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Hitchcock moved that Resolution No. 615 be adopted. Councilman Klusman seconded the motion, the record of the vote is as follows:

Councilman Hitchcock moved we waive the further reading of this Ordinance. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Klusman moved that Ordinance No. 237-A be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of the vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Wright and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Mayor Ludlow stated a motion should be made to instruct the City Clerk to issue a temporary permit for a mattress shop at 1103 Cravens Avenue. Councilman Klusman moved this permit be issued. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Mayor Ludlow stated a motion should be made to issue gas and oil to Miss Odell the young lady taking care of the playgrounds. Councilman Stanger moved we allow the gas and oil to Miss Odell upon proper authorization. Councilman Klusman seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

ORDINANCE NO. 250

AN ORDINANCE FIXING SALARIES AND PENAL

ORDINANCE NO. 251

PARKING

Councilman Hitchcock moved Ordinance No. 251 be amended to read one hour parking and be approved for its first reading. Councilman Wright seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Klusman stated it was against the State Law to put the Civil Service proposition on the ballot and moved that the resolution authorizing such procedure be rescinded as it interferes with the State Law. No second to this motion.

Oral Communications:

Mr. J.C. Smith presented a plan of a proposed paper mill to be located on lots adjacent to the City Yard on Western Avenue. Councilman Stanger moved this be referred to a committee consisting of Attorney Rippy, Engineer Leonard and Councilman Hitchcock to make investigation. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that all bills properly audited be paid. Councilman Wright seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Wright and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the meeting be adjourned. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Mayor Ludlow declared the meeting adjourned at 8:40 P.M.
