MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, July 31st., 1934.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ludlow at 7:30 P.M.

City Clerk Bartlett called the roll. Those answering present were Councilmen: Hitchcock, Klusman, Tolson and Ludlow. Absent: Councilman: Stanger. A recess was declared to await Councilman Stanger's arrival. He arrived at 7:35 P.M.

Mayor Ludlow stated this being an adjourned meeting the regular order of business is suspended.

Mayor Ludlow stated the meeting was called to pass Ordinance No. 254 authorizing issuance of bonds. Attorney Rippy said Ordinance No. 254 had been amended at the last regular meeting to provide for the issuance of \$200,000.00 bonds, with interest rate of 5%, and numbered from 1 to 200, inclusive, eight bonds to be retired yearly, and read title to amended

ORDINANCE NO. 254

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF ACT OF 1927 MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000.00), AUTHORIZED AT A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD SEPTEMBER 25, 1930, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING A WATER WORKS SYSTEM FOR SAID DISTRICT, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 212 OF SAID CITY.

Councilman Stanger moved that the further reading of Ordinance No. 254 be dispensed with. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Stanger moved that Ordinance No. 254 be adopted for final reading. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Attorney Rippy recommended the "Notice of Sale of Bonds" should be published in the Los Angeles Daily Journal. After some discussion, Councilman Stanger moved the "Notice of Sale of Bonds" be published in the Los Angeles Daily Journal for three (3) consecutive days beginning August 2nd. or 3rd., all bids to be in by August 10th. at 4:00 o'clock P.M. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Attorney Rippy stated there was one amendment to be made to Ordinance No. 255 regulating the business of Second Hand Dealers, Second Hand Auto Parts Dealers, Junk Dealers and Junk Collectors, to the effect that it should include washing machines and other electrical appliances. He then read title

ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF SECOND HAND DEALERS, SECOND HAND AUTO PARTS DEALERS, JUNK DEALERS AND JUNK COLLECTORS.

Councilman Stanger moved that the further reading of Ordinance No. 255 be dispensed with. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that Ordinance No. 255 as amended be approved for its first reading. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Mayor Ludlow requested a resolution be drawn with reference to the Board of Education's program of reconstructing the school buildings in Torrance, requesting that the Soule Steel Company be given consideration in connection with the purchase of steel for the reinforcing. Attorney Rippy read

Councilman Tolson moved that Resolution No. 639 be adopted. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

City Clerk Bartlett stated Mr. Murray L. Rasch in the audience requested permission to sell glazed do-nuts to grocers without taking out a license. Mr. Rasch stated he served about six stores in Torrance delivering the do-nuts and taking their orders for the next delivery. After considerable discussion, this was referred to Attorney Rippy for further investigation to report at next regular meeting.

Councilman Tolson moved the Council appropriate funds to complete a concession stand at the park, the estimated amount not to exceed \$200.00. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Stanger moved authorize the appropriation of \$101.59 to pay for overhauling and painting Dodge Sedan. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that warrants be drawn for all bills properly audited. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the meeting be adjourned to Friday, August 10th., 1934, at 4 o'clock P.M. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Mayor Ludlow declared the meeting adjourned at 8:25 P.M.
