MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, February 19th., 1935.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ludlow at 7:45 P.M.

City Clerk Bartlett called the roll. Those answering present were Councilmen: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger and Ludlow. Absent: Councilman: Tolson.

Mayor Ludlow stated this being an adjourned meeting the regular order of business is suspended.

Attorney Rippy reported that Mr. Dwight W. Stephenson, Legal Adviser, Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works in Los Angeles had advised that a copy of proposed bond Ordinance No. 263 as amended had been forwarded to Washington for approval and suggested its final adoption be held up until a reply had been received from the Government.

Attorney Rippy read title

ORDINANCE NO. 264

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE,  
LIMITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF ARLINGTON  
AVENUE, AND ON A PORTION OF BORDER AVENUE.

Councilman Stanger moved the further reading of Ordinance No. 264 be dispensed with. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Stanger moved that Ordinance No. 264 be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Tolson.

Mr. Kotthoff, proprietor of the "K Kow Shed Restaurant" in the Waleria District requested the Council to reconsider their action in denying him a license to do business and presented a communication signed by 39 residents of Waleria stating they have no complaint against the operation of the "K Kow Shed Restaurant" and consider it an asset to the community. After some discussion, Councilman Klusman moved we grant the gentleman his license. Motion lost for want of a second. Councilman Klusman then moved we give him a temporary permit. Motion lost for want of a second. Councilman Stanger suggested that the matter of a temporary permit be referred to the Chief of Police. Councilman Klusman moved the Chief of Police be authorized to grant Mr. Kotthoff a temporary permit to do business from Saturday, February 23rd., 1935, to Tuesday, February 26th., 1935, inclusive, if it is the Chief's opinion such a permit should be issued. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

At this time Mayor Ludlow requested Councilman Hitchcock take the chair and excused himself from the meeting.

Councilman Stanger moved that the meeting be adjourned. Councilman Klusman seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Mayor Pro-tem Hitchcock declared the meeting adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
