MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Monday, March 4th., 1935.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ludlow at 7:45 P.M.

City Clerk Bartlett called the roll. Those answering present were Councilmen: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger and Ludlow. Absent: Councilman: Tolson.

Mayor Ludlow stated this being an adjourned meeting the regular order of business is suspended.

City Clerk Bartlett read a Bulletin from the League of California Municipalities relative to Federal Relief Legislation and regarding present and future S.E.R.A. projects.

A communication from Southern California Business Men's Association referring to Senate Bill #536 and Assembly Bill #1307 was read. Clerk Bartlett was requested to contact the Los Angeles County League of Municipalities with reference to the bills.

City Clerk Bartlett read a communication from County of Los Angeles, Department of Health, with reference to Assembly Bill #542.

Attorney Rippy presented Ordinance No. 263 as amended and read title to

ORDINANCE NO. 263

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF ACT OF 1927 MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$128,000.00), AUTHORIZED AT A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD SEPTEMBER 25, 1930, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING A WATER WORKS SYSTEM FOR SAID DISTRICT AND THE SALE OF SAID BONDS TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AT PRIVATE SALE, AND AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKS FOR CERTIFICATION OF SAID BONDS AS LEGAL INVESTMENT FOR BANKS.

Councilman Stanger moved the further reading of Ordinance No. 263 as amended be dispensed with. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Stanger moved Ordinance No. 263 as amended be adopted for its final reading. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Tolson.

Councilman Hitchcock moved the City Attorney be authorized to confer with Attorney Stephenson of Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works, Los Angeles, California, for the purpose of authorizing the printing of the bonds. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Tolson.

City Clerk Bartlett requested some action by the Council with reference to the "K Kowshed Restaurant" license. Councilman Stanger moved the City Clerk be instructed to issue a restaurant license to Mr. Kotthoff. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously. Councilman Tolson absent.

Mr. Summers, City Electrical Inspector, presented a proposed Electrical Ordinance prohibiting the sale of certain electrical appliances, and recommended its adoption. No action was taken.

At this time Mayor Ludlow appointed the following committee to investigate the proposed Library Project:

No further business appearing before the Council, Councilman Klusman moved that the meeting be adjourned. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.
