MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Friday, May 10th., 1935.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ludlow at 4:30 P.M.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll. Those answering present were Councilmen: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger and Ludlow. Absent: Councilmen: Tolson.

Mayor Ludlow stated the special meeting was called for the purpose of adopting a resolution authorizing and empowering the Mayor to accept and agree to conditions in behalf of Government Unit.

City Clerk Bartlett read Resolution No. 699 in full. Councilman Klusman moved that Resolution No. 699 be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Tolson. Councilman Tolson arrived at 4:40 P.M.
