

MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned regular meeting in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Monday, June 1st., 1936 at 4:30 P.M.

Mayor Stanger called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being
Councilmen: Hitchcock, McGuire, Tolson and Stanger. Absent:
Councilman: Powell.

The regular order of business was suspended.

Clerk Bartlett read a Notice to Quit premises known as Lots 9 and 10, Block 9, Torrance Tract, from the Torrance Mutual Building & Loan Association.
