MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a regular meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday evening, February 23, 1937 at 7:45 p.m.

Mayor Stanger called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. Absent: Councilmen: None.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the minutes of an adjourned regular meeting held February 15, 1937 and of an adjourned meeting of an adjourned regular meeting held February 18, 1937 be approved as written. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS

Communication from the Torrance Chamber of Commerce requesting appropriation of \$400.00 for folders and maps.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that this request be granted. Councilman McGuire seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Communication from Henry C. Kline, owner of the building at 1211-1213 El Prado, regarding Mr. Bert M. Sharon's request for a permit to operate a billiard parlor at that address.

Councilman McGuire moved that the City Clerk be authorized to contact the owner of the present license, the two men seeking a new license, and the owner of the building, in an endeavor to straighten out the matter and to issue a license to one of the men. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Attorney Rippy presented and read in full:

Councilman Hitchcock moved that all bills properly audited be paid. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried by

the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 7:55 P.M., upon motion of Councilman Hitchcock, seconded by Councilman Tolson, the meeting adjourned to Thursday, February 25, 1937 at 4:30 P.M.
