MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING OF
AN ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Meeting of an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, August 29, 1939 at 4:30 P.M.

Mayor Tolson called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Hitchcock, Murray, Powell and Tolson. Absent: Councilmen: McGuire.

Mayor Tolson declared a recess to await the arrival of Councilman McGuire, who appeared at 4:37 .

Being an adjourned meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with.

After considerable discussion on the merits of a Mack Fire Truck which it is proposed to lease, Mayor Tolson moved that \$2000.00 be appropriated for the rental or lease of a Mack Fire Truck, together with equipment, for a period of one year, and with the option to renew such lease or purchase said truck at the end of the year. Councilman Powell seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

The question of compensation for sick leave for George W. Dolton, of the Police Department was discussed, and in accordance with a ruling adopted December 13, 1932, Mayor Tolson moved that George W. Dolton be allowed full time pay for the first fifteen days of his illness and half time pay for the next fifteen days. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

A communication was read from John H. Stroh, Chief of Police recommending the installation of traffic stop blinker lights at the following locations: Marcelina and Sartori Avenues, Western and Border Avenues, Carson Street and Cabrillo Avenue going west, Hawthorne and Highway 101 going south and Hawthorne and Torrance Boulevard.

Mayor Tolson moved that \$142.50, plus tax, be appropriated for five traffic stop blinker lights. Councilman Murray second-

ed the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.


Councilman Hitchcock showed plans for the proposed improvement and beautification of Madrid Park and El Prado Park, explaining that all the work would be done by S.R.A. labor. A discussion then ensued on the suggested improvement, whereupon Councilman Hitchcock moved that \$475.00 be appropriated for material for a sprinkling system for Madrid Park. Councilman McGuire seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 5:22 P.M., upon motion of Mayor Tolson, seconded by Councilman Hitchcock, the meeting adjourned.
