

S E V E N T H M E E T I N G

Torrance, Calif.
June 22, 1921.

An adjourned meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance was called to order in the offices of the Dominguez Land Corporation at 8:00 P. M. by President Pro-tem W. H. Gilbert.

The following members answered roll call.
Trustees Fitzhugh, Gilbert and Smith. Absent President Proctor and Trustee Stone.

The Clerk presented a map of Tract 4070 and a resolution to the effect that the streets on the above map be accepted for public use. After considerable discussion as to who is to bear the burden of paving the said streets, the Clerk was instructed to communicate with the Dominguez Land Corporation, asking them to state that they agree to pave all the streets of Tract 4070. This in consideration of the City's acceptance of the streets and in further view of the fact that the prices of the lots cover the cost of the paving.

On motion the meeting adjourned until Tuesday night at 8:00 P. M. June the 28th.
