MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Friday, March 27, 1942 at 5:00 P.M.

Mayor McGuire called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. Absent: Councilmen: Kail.

Being an adjourned meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with.

WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

A Notice of Motion for Injunction, Pendente Lite, filed by William P. Barta and John R. Barta, Attorneys for Plaintiffs L. P. Liston, L. I. Liston and H. T. Bernhard, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Coast Brick Company, and naming as defendants The City of Torrance, T. F. McGuire, James E. Hitchcock, K. H. Kail, L. V. Babcock, George V. Powell, John E. McCall and John H. Stroh, was read, advising that the above entitled action will be heard in the Courtroom of Department 22 in the Superior Court of the State of California in and for the County of Los Angeles, at 10:00 A.M. April 7, 1942.

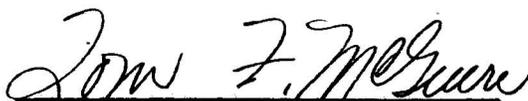
