MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Friday, August 27, 1943, at 5:00 P.M.

Mayor McGuire called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll; those answering present being Councilmen: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. Absent: Councilmen: Cucci.

Being an Adjourned Regular Meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with.

WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

Clerk Bartlett presented and read title to:

RESOLUTION NO. 1603

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TORRANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1943-44 AND CHANGING
TIME OF BI-MONTHLY SALARY AND WAGE PAYMENTS.

Councilman Babcock moved that Resolution No. 1603 be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Cucci.

Councilman Hitchcock stated he thought it would be advisable to delegate Mr. Bernhard D. Bunje, Chairman of the Civil Service Board, to attend the Thirty-Fifth Annual Conference on Public Personnel Administration, sponsored by the Civil Service Assembly of the United States and Canada, to be held at St. Louis, Missouri, on October 12, 13 and 14, 1943.

Whereupon, Councilman Hitchcock moved that Mr. Bernhard D. Bunje be authorized to attend the Conference sponsored by the Civil Service Assembly of the United States and Canada, of which the City of Torrance is a member, to be held in St. Louis, Missouri, on October 12, 13 and 14, 1943, with expenses paid. Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Cucci.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the members of the City Council, and any other persons appointed by the Council, be authorized to attend the Annual Conference of the Municipal League of California Cities, to be held in Sacramento, California, on October 19, 20 and 21, 1943, with expenses paid. Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN:

Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None.
 ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Cucci.

Engineer Jain advised that he had received a communication from the Los Angeles County Road Department stating that the City will receive the sum of \$812.07, for the purpose of making surveys and preparing plans and specifications for post-war construction projects.

Mr. Dale Riley stated he had received an offer to purchase the slide at WALTERIA, but did not recommend its sale. He suggested, however, that the slide be moved to the School grounds, where it will be under supervision.

Mr. Riley also stated that the Day Nursery School, at the Municipal Park will be in need of heat before long.

Councilman Powell moved that Engineer Jain investigate this matter and see how much material will be required and submit his recommendation to the Council, together with an estimate of the cost.

Engineer Jain advised that he was of the opinion that the necessary heating equipment should be installed by the Los Angeles City School Board.

Councilman Powell then withdrew his motion.

At 5:35 P.M., on motion of Councilman Hitchcock, seconded by Councilman Babcock, the meeting adjourned.
