The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Ad-
journed Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance,
California, on Friday, April 12, 1946 at 7:45 P.M.

Mayor Tolson called the meeting to order.


Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being
Councilmen: Hitchcock, Powell and Tolson. Absent: Councilmen:
Gucci and Gilbert.

Clerk Bartlett declared that the purpose of the meeting is to
canvass absentee ballots of the April 9, 1946 General Municipal
Election, but, since there are still four absentee ballots out-
standing, the canvass cannot be made at this time, and it is there-
fore necessary to adjourn the meeting until April 13, 1946 and
from day to day until all ballots are in, or until April 16, 1946
has been reached.

by Councilman Powell, the meeting adjourned to Saturday, April 13,
1946 at 7:45 P.M. for the purpose of canvassing absentee ballots.
