MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Ad-
journed Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance,
California, on Monday, April 15, 1946 at 7:45 P.M.

Mayor Tolson called the meeting to order.


Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being
Councilmen: Tolson and Powell. Absent: Councilmen: Cucci,
Gilbert and Hitchcock.

Clerk Bartlett declared that the purpose of the meeting is
to canvass absentee ballots of the April 9, 1946 General Municipal
Election, but since there are still four absentee ballots out-
standing, the canvass cannot be made at this time, and it is there-
fore necessary to adjourn the meeting until April 16, 1946 for
the express purpose of canvassing the absentee ballots and to
canvass the returns of the April 9, 1946 Election and install the
newly elected officers.

At 7:47 P.M., upon motion of Councilman Powell, seconded by
Mayor Tolson, the meeting adjourned to April 16, 1946, 7:45 P.M.
for the purpose above stated by Clerk Bartlett.
