MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, April 29, 1947, at 8:00 p.m.

Mayor Sherfey called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Gilbert, Jackson, Powell, Tolson and Sherfey. Absent: Councilmen: None.

All those present in the Council Chamber saluted the Flag.

Mayor Sherfey announced that the regular order of business would be dispensed with; and that this Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance has been called for the purpose of considering repair and reconstruction of the central Fire Station, and any other matters, including appropriations for labor and materials, in connection therewith.

At 8:08 p.m., upon motion by Councilman Powell, seconded by Councilman Jackson, the Council retired for a thirty-minute recess, for the purpose of discussing more fully the above matter.

At 8:25 p.m., the Council reconvened and Mayor Sherfey called the meeting to order.

Councilman Tolson moved that the City Council does deem it of urgent necessity for the protection of life, health and property that the City contract and purchase such materials and supplies as may be necessary for the repair of the central Fire Station, without advertising for bids. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Gilbert, Jackson, Powell, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Tolson moved that Mr. W. M. Bostock, Structural Engineer, 8414 Otis Street, South Gate, be employed to prepare the plans and specifications for the repair of the central Fire Station. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Gilbert, Jackson, Powell, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Tolson moved that Mr. Sam Levy, 1503 El Prado, be employed as technical adviser in the repair of the central Fire Station, at a salary of \$1.00 per month, on a temporary basis. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Gilbert, Jackson, Powell, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 8:30 p.m., upon motion by Councilman Tolson, seconded by Councilman Jackson, the meeting adjourned.
