MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Monday, July 14, 1947, at 5:20 p.m.

All Councilmen were notified of this meeting more than three hours in advance.

Mayor Sherfey called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Jackson, Powell, Tolson and Sherfey. Absent: Councilmen: Gilbert.

All those present in the Council Chamber saluted the Flag.

This being a Special Meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with.

Mayor Sherfey announced that this Special Meeting has been called for the purpose of passing a resolution directing and authorizing the Mayor to file application on behalf of the City of Torrance with the War Assets Administration for the transfer to the City of Torrance of the Lomita Flight Strip-W-Cal-41.

Clerk Bartlett presented and read title to:

RESOLUTION NO. 1842

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE DIRECTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE WITH THE WAR ASSETS ADMINISTRATION FOR THE TRANSFER TO THE CITY OF TORRANCE OF THE LOMITA FLIGHT STRIP-W-Cal-41.

Councilman Tolson moved that Resolution No. 1842 be adopted. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Jackson, Powell, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: GILBERT.

At 5:25 p.m., upon motion by Councilman Tolson, seconded by Councilman Jackson and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned.
