MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Ad-journed Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, March 2, 1948, at 8:35 p.m.

Mayor Sherfey called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Buxton, Gilbert, Jackson, Tolson and Sherfey. Absent: Councilmen: None.

Mayor Sherfey announced that this being an adjourned meeting, the regular order of business would be dispensed with.

Clerk Bartlett presented and read:

RESOLUTION NO. 1893

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE INCREASING, TEMPORARILY,
COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE, AND ADOPTION OF FIVE
STEP PAY RANGE PLAN OF SALARIES.

Councilman Gilbert moved that further reading of Resolution No. 1893 be dispensed with. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Gilbert moved that Resolution No. 1893 be adopted. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Buxton, Gilbert, Jackson, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Clerk Bartlett presented and read title to:

RESOLUTION NO. 1894

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE CALLING FOR A GENERAL
MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE
13TH DAY OF APRIL, 1948.

Councilman Gilbert moved that Resolution No. 1894 be adopted. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Buxton, Gilbert, Jackson, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Tolson moved that W. H. Stanger, Manager of Water District No. 2, be authorized to write a letter, on behalf of the Council, to the U. S. Pipe and Foundry Company, setting out the state of destitution of the 2500 acre area of District No. 2, and appealing to the pipe manufacturer in an effort to expedite pipe delivery to relieve the situation. Councilman Buxton seconded the motion which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Gilbert moved that the City Council instruct the City Attorney to write an amendment to Land Use Ordinance No. 316 setting a minimum of 5000 square feet per lot with a minimum of 50 foot frontage, for the entire City of Torrance. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion which was carried unanimously.

Mayor Sherfey moved that Taylor and Taylor, Engineers, be authorized to proceed with the preparation of plans, specifications and invitations to bid for completion of as much of the pipe laying in Municipal Water District No. 2 as delivery of pipe will permit; bids to provide alternate proposals for laying city's pipe and for laying pipes supplied by pipe line contractors. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion which was carried unanimously.
