MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, April 6, 1948, at 7:45 p.m.

Mayor Sherfey called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Buxton, Gilbert, Jackson, Tolson and Sherfey. Absent: Councilmen: None.

Mayor Sherfey announced that this being a Special Meeting the regular order of business would be dispensed with. He further announced that this Special Meeting of the City Council was called for the purpose of approving Final Map of Tract No. 14898.

City Administrator Stevens explained that Subdivision Map of Tract No. 14898, filed by the Riviera Housing Corporation, had been previously approved by the City Council, but that due to a change in ownership it is necessary to reapprove the map and accept the streets offered for dedication for public use, and recommended that the Council take such action.

Councilman Gilbert moved that Final Map of Tract No. 14898 be reapproved as recommended by City Administrator Stevens. Councilman Buxton seconded the motion which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Gilbert, Buxton, Jackson, Tolson and Sherfey. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 7:50 p.m., upon motion of Councilman Tolson, seconded by Councilman Gilbert, and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned.
