MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Wednesday, May 5, 1948, at 7:45 p.m.

Mayor Sherfey called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Drale, Haggard, Powell and Sherfey. Absent: Councilmen: Jackson.

Mayor Sherfey announced that, this being an Adjourned Meeting, the regular order of business would be dispensed with.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from Alice Lee, requesting a license to conduct the business of Palmistry at 1956 Torrance Boulevard, in the City of Torrance.

Clerk Bartlett advised that this request had been referred to the Chief of Police, and had been sent back with the notation, "No comment".

Councilman Haggard moved that the application of Alice Lee for a license to conduct the business of Palmistry be denied. Councilman Powell seconded the motion which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Drale explained that the City of Los Angeles is denying all requests for a Palmistry license, and therefore he did not think that they should be allowed to come into the City of Torrance.

Councilman Drale moved that the meeting be adjourned; to meet informally with the Civil Service Board. Councilman Haggard seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.
