MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber of the City Hall on Thursday, January 5, 1950, at 12:23 p.m.

In the absence of Mayor Sherfey, Councilman Jackson moved that Councilman Powell act as Mayor. Motion, seconded by Councilman Haggard, carried. Mayor pro tem Powell called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those being present were:  
COUNCILMEN: Haggard, Jackson and Powell. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN:  
Drale and Sherfey. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Smith.

Mayor pro tem Powell announced that this being a Special Meeting, the regular order of business would be dispensed with, and that the meeting was called for the purpose of considering approval of Final Map of Tract No. 16099 and Tract No. 16195.

The Council having been present at the Planning Commission meeting at 12:00 noon, Councilman Haggard moved that the Council approve the Final Map of Tracts 16099 and 16195, with the stipulation that Lots 226, 227 and 228, of Tract 16099, be deeded to the City for playground purposes, that the premises along Crenshaw and along 190th St. be landscaped, and that not more than 20% of the houses in the subdivision will be of the 750 square foot type. Motion, seconded by Councilman Jackson, carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Haggard, Jackson and Powell. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Drale and Sherfey. NAYS: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 12:27 p.m., Councilman Jackson moved meeting be adjourned. Motion, seconded by Councilman Haggard, carried unanimously.
