

MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

An adjourned regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California November 28, 1922, and was called to order by President Fitzhugh at 7:25 P.M. ORDINANCE NO. 40
