MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber of the City Hall on Tuesday, February 6, 1951, at 6:30 p.m., Mayor Haggard presiding.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Karlow, Spelman and Haggard. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Drale. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Hall.

This being a Special Meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with and the Mayor announced the meeting was called for the purpose of approving Tract Map No. 14707, submitted by Property Management Corporation, and any other business which might come before the Council.

City Clerk Bartlett read a letter from Property Management Corporation, in which they stated that they would install curbs, gutters and pavement on 174th Street, between Crenshaw Boulevard and the westerly line of Tract No. 14545.

Councilman Blount moved that the Final Map for Tract No. 14707 be accepted with the provision that curb, gutter and sidewalk be installed along the south side of 174th Street between Crenshaw Boulevard and the westerly end of Tract No. 14545 and that the roadway between the existing pavement and the new gutter, between Crenshaw Boulevard and the westerly end of Tract No. 14545, be surfaced with a pavement to meet the requirements of the Division of Highways, further, that the same type of construction be installed on the west side of Crenshaw Boulevard from 174th Street to the southerly line of Tract No. 14707, all subject to concurrence by the Planning Commission. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m. on motion of Councilman Spelman, seconded by Councilman Blount.
