

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

Torrance, California
August 27, 1951

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting on Monday, August 27, 1951, at 8:00 P.M. in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, Mayor Haggard presiding.

Those answering to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were: COUNCILMEN: Drale, Karlow, Spelman and Haggard. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Blount. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Hall.

This being a special meeting, Mayor Haggard announced the regular order of business would be dispensed with and that the meeting had been called for the purpose of holding the first public hearing on the proposed 1951-1952 Budget.

At the request of the Mayor, City Manager Stevens presented the proposed budget, stating it had been revised and amended to meet the estimated income based on assessed valuation, which figures had been received from the County. The tax rate established remains the same as for the past two years -- \$1.12. He recommended a 20¢ water tax rate for North and South Torrance. Following a brief discussion, the City Clerk was instructed to incorporate such a change in the Resolution establishing tax rates for the new fiscal year.

On motion of Councilman Spelman, seconded by Councilman Drale and unanimously carried, meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
