MINUTES OF A HEARING BEFORE THE
TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL ON PROPOSED
ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED
TERRITORY.

A hearing was called for Wednesday, June 3, 1953, at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California.

There being no quorum present, Councilman Blount recessed the hearing until 8:20 p.m.

The City Council reconvened at 8:20 p.m.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were:
COUNCILMEN: Benstead, Blount, Drale and Spelman. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Schwab. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Hall.

Councilman Blount moved Councilman Spelman be appointed Mayor pro tem. Motion, seconded by Councilman Drale, carried unanimously by those present.


Councilman Drale led the salute to our Flag.

Mayor pro tem Spelman announced this was the time and place set for the hearing in connection with the proposed annexation to the City of Torrance of certain uninhabited territory in the City of Redondo Beach.

City Clerk Bartlett said he had the notices of publication, which have been duly published and printed, and no written communications were received.

There being no written or oral protests, Councilman Blount moved all protests be denied and the hearing closed. Motion, seconded by Councilman Drale, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.

At 8:30 p.m. Councilman Blount moved the meeting adjourn. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried unanimously by those present.
