MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Monday, March 1, 1954, at 8:00 P.M., Mayor Schwab presiding.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were:

Councilman Spelman moved to dispense with the regular order of business. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried unanimously by those present.

Mayor Schwab announced the Special Meeting of the City Council was called for the purpose of approving specifications for the construction of Storm Drain Bond Issue Project No. 2, Lomita Boulevard Storm Drain in the Cities of Los Angeles and Torrance and the County of Los Angeles, California.
