MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, March 16, 1954, at 8:00 P.M. Mayor Schwab presiding.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were: COUNCILMEN: Benstead, Blount, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Hall.

Councilman Spelman led the salute to our Flag.

Mayor Schwab announced as this was an Adjourned Regular Meeting, the regular order of business would be dispensed with.

City Clerk Bartlett said the purpose of this adjourned meeting was for the second reading of Ordinance No. 685.

City Clerk Bartlett presented and read in full:

ORDINANCE NO. 685

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE ON THE 13TH DAY OF APRIL, 1954, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY PROPOSITIONS TO INCUR BONDED, INDEBTEDNESS BY SAID CITY FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS, AND CONSOLIDATING SAID ELECTION WITH THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SAID DATE.

Councilman Blount moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 685, at its second and final reading. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously by roll call vote.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

Cleta Holly, 18415 Falda, inquired about the investigation regarding Tract No. 17560. She said Mr. Laramore made a lot of promises about fixing the homes but has done nothing about it.

City Attorney Hall said the State Housing Division has assigned Mr. Armstrong as the investigator, but to date he has not received a report from him.

After a general discussion, the Council requested City Manager Stevens to meet with Mr. Laramore and see what he intends to do, so they will have an answer for these people at the next Council meeting.

At 8:20 P.M., Councilman Spelman moved to adjourn. Motion, seconded by Councilman Blount, carried unanimously.
