MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, on Wednesday, September 15, 1954, at 5:00 p.m., Mayor Drale presiding.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were: COUNCILMEN: Benstead, Isen, Schwab and Drale. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Blount. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Hall.

Councilman Benstead led the salute to our Flag.

Mayor Drale announced as this was an Adjourned Regular Meeting the regular order of business would be dispensed with.

City Clerk Bartlett presented the report on fireworks sales, as requested by the City Council.

Councilman Isen moved the report be received and filed. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried by those present.

Councilman Isen moved the request of the Disabled American Veteran's, for a refund of portions of their fireworks license fee in the amount of \$102.98, or any other sum, be denied. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.

City Clerk Bartlett read title to:

RESOLUTION NO. 2625

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE BY SAID CITY OF TAX ANTICIPATION WARRANTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1954-1955 IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00 TO MATURE DECEMBER 31, 1954.

Councilman Benstead moved to dispense with further reading of the Resolution. Motion, seconded by Councilman Schwab, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.

Councilman Isen moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 2625. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.

ORDINANCE NO. 706

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF, A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE ON THE 19TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1954, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY TWO PROPOSITIONS TO INCUR BONDED INDEBTEDNESS BY SAID CITY FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS.

Councilman Schwab moved to dispense with further reading of the Ordinance. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.

Councilman Isen moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 706, at its second and final reading. Motion, seconded by Councilman Benstead, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.
