

MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

Torrance, California.  
August 28, 1926.

An adjourned regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chamber at Torrance, California, August 28, 1926, and was called to order by President Dennis at 2.00 P. M. The following Trustees were present: Foley, Inman and Dennis. Absent, Brooks and Wolfe.

The regular order of business was dispensed with.

Attorney Briney read:

RESOLUTION NO. 298  
A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL  
ELECTION OF AUGUST, 27, 1926.

Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance that this Board has duly canvassed the returns of the special election held in the City of Torrance on the 27th day of August, 1926, and finds that there were cast a total number of 553 votes at said election, that of said total there were 355 votes in favor of and 198

votes against the proposition submitted at said election, and that as a result of said election the ordinance No. 130 being "An ordinance of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance, providing for the levy and collection of a tax of ten (10) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of property for parks, music and advertising purposes, and providing for an election to be held in the City of Torrance to determine whether this ordinance shall become effective", was approved by a majority of the voters voting at said election and the same is therefore in full force and effect.

Trustee Inman moved that Resolution No. 298 be adopted as read and same filed in the office of the City Clerk. Trustee Foley seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: Trustees: Foley, Inman and Dennis.

NOES: Trustees: None.

ABSENT: Trustees: Brooks and Wolfe.

Attorney Briney read:

RESOLUTION NO. 299  
FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR 1926-1927.

Trustee Foley moved that Resolution No. 299 be adopted as read and same filed in the office of the City Clerk. Trustee Inman seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

Trustee Foley moved that all bills, properly audited, be paid. Trustee Inman seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

ABSENT: Trustees: Brooks, Wolfe.

At 2.35 P.M. Trustee Foley moved to adjourn until 8.30 P.M. Monday, August 30, 1926. Trustee Inman seconded the motion which was duly carried.
