MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, Dec. 20, 1927, and was called to order at 7:45 p.m. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Councilmen were present: Raymond, Wolfe and Dennis.
Absent: Conner and Inman.

The minutes of the regular meeting of December 6, 1927, were read and approved as read.

A petition, signed by 118 residents of the Mexican Pueblo, protested against allowing Mr. Ybarro to hold dances in that locality. Same was referred to the Clerk for checking and report at next meeting.

A letter, signed by L. A. Monreal and Albert Velarde, requested that the pool room license issued to Mr. Ybarro be transferred to them, assuring the Board that the pool room would be operated in accordance with the laws and regulations of the City. Mr. Monreal stated that it was not the intention to hold dances in the pool hall except for the opening night.

Two letters accompanied the request.
Councilman Wolfe moved that the request be granted. Councilman Raymond seconded the motion, which was duly carried.

A communication protesting against the high peddling license was received from Scudder Food Products.
Same was to be taken up with other protests along the same line.

A petition containing 58 signatures, protesting against the rezoning of Arlington Ave. from Carson to 218th, was read by the Clerk.

A petition, concerning the rezoning of Lot 20, Block 21, Torrance Tract, was filed by W. W. Mitchell.

Councilman Raymond moved that the above two petitions be referred to the Clerk for checking and that the hearing scheduled for tonight regarding this rezoning be continued until the next meeting. Councilman Wolfe seconded the motion, which was duly carried.

The Mayor asked for oral communications. Mr. Klusman obtained the floor, but was ruled out of order when he called the City Attorney a "shyster," and was again ruled out of order when he called Mr. Kingsley the publicity agent for the Council; Mayor Dennis stating that personal animosity would not be countenanced in the Council Chamber.

Mr. Hyde stated that the Council was soon to be asked to approve the plan of a metropolitan survey for industries in this territory; that the plan would give us the advantage of being classed separately from Los Angeles.

Engineer Leonard presented three maps of proposed subdivisions, recommending that same be approved.
