MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE.

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, November 5th., 1930, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Trustees: Bell, Nelson, Smith, Steiner and Dennis.

Absent: Trustees: None.

Trustee Steiner moved that the minutes of the regular meeting of October 21st., 1930, be adopted.

Trustee Smith seconded the motion

Trustee Bell introduced:

ORDINANCE NO. 211.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF HAND BILLS AND OTHER PAMPHLETS, NOTICES AND ADVERTISEMENTS, AND THE POSTING OF STICKERS OR OTHER PLACARDS OR NOTICES WITHIN SAID CITY.

Attorney Briney reported with reference to the water litigation, that the plaintiff had asked for two weeks continuance of the hearing in order to show cause against the defendants for the purpose of deciding whether the plaintiff will amend his complaint in the Federal Court to attempt to more clearly show jurisdiction in the Federal Court, or whether they will stand upon their present complaint or whether they will dismiss the present Federal Court action and file a new suit in the State Court.

At 8:05 P. M. Trustee Bell and Attorney Briney were excused from the meeting.

Oral communications were next in order.

A gentleman in the audience made application for a Mr. C. G. Lee, to conduct a vehicle lunchstand in front of 4910 Redondo-Riverside Blvd. east of Prairie Avenue. This stand is to be on an automobile chassis and will be operated in the same location each day, but will be taken home at night and brought back the next morning.

Trustee Steiner moved that the licenses be granted for \$3.00 a quarter. Trustee Smith seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Mr. Earl Conner on behalf of the American Legion Bert S. Crossland Post, extended the Council and City Officials an invitation to participate in parade and exercises of the Legion on Armistice Day.

This invitation was accepted.

Trustee Smith stated that he had a very good offer from P. A. Murphy, 524 Locust Street, Long Beach, California, to trade in the present motorcycle in the Police Department for a 1931 Harley-Davidson 74 equipped with luggage carrier, Jiffy stand and Warner speedometer,



Trustee Smith seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:


