MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, December 18th., 1930, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Clerk Bartlett who stated that it was customary for the Board to appoint one of the members chairman to act during the absence of the Mayor.

Trustee Smith moved that Trustee Nelson act as temporary chairman of the Board.

Trustee Steiner seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Trustee Nelson then took the chair.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll and the following Trustees responded: Trustees: Bell, Smith, Steiner and Nelson.

Absent: Trustees: Dennis.

This being an adjourned meeting the regular order of business was dispensed with.

ORDINANCE NO. 212.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) OF BONDS OF ACT OF 1927 MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, AUTHORIZED BY THE VOTERS OF SUCH DISTRICT AT A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD SEPTEMBER 25, 1930, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING A WATER PRODUCING AND DISTRIBUTING SYSTEM FOR SAID DISTRICT INCLUDING WELLS, PUMPS, TANKS, RESERVOIRS, DISTRIBUTION MAINS, LANDS, RIGHTS OF WAY, AND EASEMENTS THEREFOR AND ALL OTHER NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES FOR A COMPLETE WATER PRODUCING, PURIFYING, AND DISTRIBUTING SYSTEM FOR THE SALE OF WATER FOR DOMESTIC, AGRICULTURAL, INDUSTRIAL AND OTHER USES.

Trustee Bell moved that the meeting be adjourned to Tuesday evening, December 30th., 1930, at 7:45 P. M.

Trustee Steiner seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.
