



Los Arboles Park (aka Rocketship Park) is located on 6.3 acres at 5101 Calle de Ricardo; which is adjacent to Riviera Elementary School. The name of the park which means "the trees," was chosen in 1956 by local school children after the land was donated by developer H. Kessel. The groundbreaking took place March 26, 1960 and was completed January 31, 1964.

The park amenities include play equipment, a swing set, and of course a three story tall Rocketship. Possibly the best feature of this park is that it offers a picturesque view of entire City; spanning as far as the Getty Center, the Hollywood sign, and Griffith Park Observatory.
