FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FUNDING

A \$1,745,800 grant from the Proposition 84 Stormwater Grant Program combined with matching funds from each city. Torrance's match contribution is \$517,866.04 from the Sewer Enterprise Fund.

NUMBER OF SIGNS

Staff is exploring signage needs within the various communities to ensure visibility of signs. In some instances, there may be a sign on each corner or 4 signs on a block. It is all contingent on the visibility of the signs and the length of the block. Signs must be installed within line of sight.

WORDING OF SIGNS

Existing "NO PARKING" signs will be modified to indicate the sweeping day and time. Also, the NO PARKING timeframe will be reduced from a 4-hour period to a 3-hour period. New NO PARKING signs will contain similar information.

SIZE AND PLACEMENT OF SIGNS

Each new sign will be 12" wide x 18" high with lettering not less than one inch in height. Signs will be posted at a height of approximately 6 to 7 feet above the ground level. These parameters comply with the uniform standards and specifications of the Department of Transportation (2012 CA Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices—Part 2 Signs) and the California Vehicle Code (CVC 22507.6).
