City Attorney Impartial Analysis

Section 510 of the Torrance City Charter now provides that general municipal elections are held on the same day as the statewide direct primary election in each even-numbers year. Currently, the statewide direct primary takes place in June of even-numbered years.

Current Charter

SECTION 510. - GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

General municipal elections shall be held in said City on the same day as the statewide direct primary election in each even numbered year.

Proposed Charter Amendment

SECTION 510. - GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

General municipal elections shall be held in said City on the last Tuesday in April same day as the statewide direct primary election in each even numbered year.
