Torrance Councilwoman Pat McIntyre Retires From Office

Torrance, Calif., June 4, 2007 – The City of Torrance announces the retirement of Torrance City Councilwoman Pat McIntyre from her office as of Sunday, June 2, 2007 due to her current health condition.

In her resignation letter, McIntyre writes, “I thank the citizens for having provided this opportunity, and my colleagues for their willingness to discuss, disagree and collaborate for the better of our governance.” McIntyre was elected to her first term on the City Council on 2002 and re-elected in June 6, 2006.

During her term on the City Council, McIntyre served as Chair of the Employee Relations Committee and member of the Citizen Development and Enrichment Committee and the Finance and Government Operations Committee. She also served as Chair of the Rose Float Ad Hoc Committee.

McIntyre’s resignation immediately creates a vacancy on the Torrance City Council. The current six-member City Council will begin to address the issue of filling the vacant seat on Tuesday, June 5, 2007, at the regularly-scheduled City Council meeting, which starts at 7:00 p.m.
