FY2009-10 Residential Slurry Seal – Areas 4 & 5 **ADVANCE NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION**

Dear Homeowner/Resident:

This Notice is to inform you that starting on Monday, October 11th, the City's contractor, Pavement Coatings Co., will begin "slurry seal" treatment on your street and/or other streets in your neighborhood. "Slurry seal" is a mixture of liquid asphalt and sand applied to streets to extend the life of the street and improve its appearance. The work will continue through the month of October.

A map of the slurry seal treatment schedule for the week beginning Monday, October 11th is on the other side of this Notice. **Schedules for future work will be posted at**

Two days prior to performing work on your street, the City's contractor will provide you with another Notice as a reminder of the specific day that your street will be slurry sealed. Be advised, that the treatment schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather and/or other reasons. However, the City intends to always provide adequate Notice of work.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS & ACCESS

To properly apply slurry seal, each street must be closed from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. to allow for the application and drying process. No vehicles will be allowed on to or out of your street until the work is complete. Access to and from your driveway also will be prohibited. If you need to use your vehicle, we suggest you park it on another nearby street, not in the work area. Temporary "NO PARKING" signs will be posted 48 hours in advance of the work and the date and time for parking restrictions will be indicated. Please move your vehicle off the street by 7:00 a.m. or your vehicle will be towed at your expense.

PLEASE NOTE: WET SLURRY SEAL WILL STAIN. Walking or driving on wet slurry will leave unsightly tracks on the roadway surface, stick to shoes, and stain car finishes and driveways. **Do not drive or walk on the slurry seal until the contractor has removed the barricades and traffic cones, which indicate the street is open to traffic. If you have a special need (i.e. medical appointment; home delivery, etc.) please contact our office so that we may try to accommodate you as best as possible.** We thank you for your cooperation and patience during the construction.
